He patrols Forest Hill, Westover Hill, Forest View and Forest View Terrace. He checks all 50 businesses each day. Recently there have been thefts from vehicles on King William Road, Stonewall Avenue and Riverside Drive. The business at 1214 Westover Hills Boulevard has recently been used as a meet up spot for a craigslist scam for iPhones. Third precinct is getting a dedicated traffic officer very soon (within the week) to supplement the department’s traffic unit. If you see Officer Cirino on the beat, say hello.</p> <p>The Honorable Kathy Graziano provided a 4<sup>th</sup> District update. On November 14<sup>th</sup> City Council will vote on the Reedy Creek proposal. The city has issued a request for proposals (RFP) to dredge Forest Hill Lake and remove built up sediment. Council continues looking for a dedicated stream of funding for schools.</p> <p>The FHNA received recognition for bringing arts to the city via the Music in the Park series, which is celebrating its 10 year anniversary.</p> <p>President Whit Clements shared an updated budget spreadsheet. Cash on hand is \$16,387.50.</p> <p>The date of the annual 5K race is March 18, 2017.</p> <p>A recent mailer has led to 65 memberships (both renewal and new).</p> <p>President Clements reminded members that at the November 15<sup>th</sup> meeting the association would elect new board members.
