# The Forest Hill Neighborhood Association Community Service Scholarship Application

The Forest Hill Neighborhood Association Community Service Scholarship is an annual scholarship of \$500 awarded to a graduating senior who lives in the Forest Hill neighborhood and who plans to attend college or other post-secondary institution. The selection process is based on 1) an application, 2) original answers to essay questions including details and documentation of service to the community, 3) a letter of reference from a non-relative who knows the applicant and knows about his or her service to the community, and 4) a copy of a letter of acceptance from the college the applicant plans to attend. Once awarded, the scholarship may be used for any college-related necessities.

The scholarship deadline will be on or around July 1 each year. The money will be awarded by the Forest Hill Neighborhood Association (FHNA) at the August meeting of the association. The selection committee will be determined every year and will consist of between three and five members of the FHNA executive board. The decision of the selection committee is final
