Linda Mills seconded the motion, and the minutes were adopted.</p> <p>Tim Grimes, Councilwoman Graziaon’s liaison, presented the 4<sup>th</sup> District Report. He noted the gas line maintenance work being done between Powwhite and Janke on Forest Hill Avenue. He also mentioned the upcoming paving of Forest Hill Avenue between Semmes and Powwhite, and of Westover Hills Boulevard between the Nickel Bridge and Forest Hill Avenue.</p> <p>Dorna Braswell presented the Social Committee report. The yard sale was successful, and the next Music in the Park, featuring Li’l Ronnie and the Grand Dukes, is from 6 to 8 p.m., on July 13.</p> <p>The guest speaker was Jake Helmboldt, who presented information regarding the Proposed Improvement Plan for Forest Hill Avenue. The plan is to mark a bike lane between Semmes and where the avenue widens at Prince George Road. Parking will still be allowed on Forest Hill Avenue. “No Parking” signs will not be posted, and there have been discussions with the police regarding allowing residents of Forest Hill Avenue to park to unload groceries and etc.</p>
