<p>MINUTES</p> <p>“... the minutes should contain mainly a record of what was done at the meeting, not what was said by the members.”</p> <p>p. 468, Robert’s Rules of Order, Newly Revised, 11th Edition</p>	<p>President Somerville called the meeting to order at 7 PM</p> <p>There was no RPD 3rd Precinct report.</p> <p>Timmy Siverd presented the 4th District Updates on behalf of Councilperson Nye who was on vacation.</p> <p>The Richmond Marathon is on November 11, and the River City Marathon (through UofR is on March 9.</p> <p>The neighborhood dialogue/informational meeting for the 700 44th Street Project is on Tuesday, 10/24, at 5:30 pm, at the Forest Hill Presbyterian Church. This project will provide affordable housing but will eliminate some wetlands and forest. Attending will be the lawyer and developer of the project. City Council may vote on this project as soon as November 6th.</p> <p>The Forest Hill Avenue/Roanoke Street intersection will be closed on Oct. 25 and Oct. 26, from 9 am-3:30 pm, for the removal of the island in the pedestrian crossing area. The island is problematic as trucks keep hitting it. They will install putting crosswalks with buttons for pedestrians.</p> <p>There will be a speed management symposium on November 8th from 5:30-8 pm at Main Street Station.</p> <p>The annual challenge of leaf removal is underway. Residents can leave up to 10 bags of leaves per week for pick-up. Email Timmy Siverd if you have problems with leaf removal (timmy.severd@rva.gov).</p>



There will be a talk regarding trees at Larus Park with lunch provided (from Underground Kitchen) on 10/27 from 12-1:30 pm.
