Link, Assistant Commonwealth Attorney, invited participants to attend an informational town hall meeting, “Where’s My Mail?”, on 2/21/24.</p> <p>Lieutenant Andorfer presented the 3<sup>rd</sup> Precinct Police report.</p> <p>Howard Glenn, Stomwater &amp; Wastewater Operations Manager for the Department of Public Utilities, provided an update on the Forest Hill Park Lake dredging. This “maintenance cleaning” is scheduled to begin March 4. Project should take 30-45 days. Last dredging was done in 2010; last maintenance cleaning was in 2018.</p> <p>Councilperson Kristen Nye presented the 4<sup>th</sup> District Report.</p> <p>A Run for the Hills 5K Update was provided.</p> <p>Forest Hill Flyers will be out shortly.</p> <p>Consultant Mark Baker introduced the owner of 1005 Westover Hills who is requesting a Special Use Permit for proposed development. The owner engaged in a period of questions and answers. A vote on the requested FHNA letter of support for the SUP is anticipated at the March meeting.</p> <p>Laura Taylor moved the adoption of the January minutes, and the motion was properly seconded. The chair ruled that the motion passed.</p>



Suzanne McWilliams moved a motion of approval of the September Mayoral Forum (September 17) and the provision of up to \$1,000 for the cost of securing a sound system for the event. The motion was properly seconded, and the chair ruled that it passed.
